ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Congratulations on being awarded a University of Hawai'i Band Achievement Scholarship! The University of Hawai'i Band achievement scholarship is awarded to promote the pride, pageantry and spirit of the University, its athletic programs and the University of Hawai'i Band Program!

INFORMATION

The band achievement scholarship covers only UH Manoa tuition. General fees, applied music fees, activity fees, housing and books are not included. It is very important that you do not refuse a scholarship or grant from the Financial Aid Office because of the availability of the band achievement scholarship. If you have been awarded any kind of financial aid not affiliated with the UH Band Department, please contact the Associate Director of Bands immediately. UH Band achievement scholarship recipients are required to pay all applicable fees (tuition, general fee, applied music, student activity fee, etc.) by the announced deadline. This may differ from the University deadlines. It is the student's responsibility to be aware of the deadline. The band achievement scholarship will be awarded in the form of a refund check later in the semester.

In the event your band achievement scholarship is withdrawn after the refund check is sent, you will be responsible for reimbursing the University for the full amount of the waiver. Should your waiver be decreased after the refund check is sent, you will be responsible for reimbursing the University the amount of the difference. Failure to reimburse the University will result in a financial obligation.

Important

To be eligible to receive a fall UH Band achievement scholarship, you **must** be registered for marching band by the final day of spring registration. **The deadline for Fall 07 registration is Friday, May 3.** To be eligible to receive a spring achievement scholarship, you **must** have auditioned and registered for your designated concert band by the final day of fall registration. In the case of not registering by this deadline, you will not be eligible to receive a UH Band achievement scholarship.

All new incoming students, both resident and non-resident must turn in a completed achievement scholarship application form by July 1 to the UH Band office. You forfeit eligibility to receive a achievement scholarship if we do not have your completed achievement scholarship application in our office by July 1. The UH Band Mailing address is:

By Hawai'i state law, UH Band Achievement scholarships are available only to UH Manoa students. Community College students are not eligible. At the beginning of each semester you must complete a UH Band achievement scholarship application form and submit it to the band office. Failure to submit this application will disqualify you from any rights to a achievement scholarship.

ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP ALLOCATION

Achievement scholarships are structured so that the longer you are an active member of the UH Band Program the more achievement scholarship money you receive. While waiver allotments cap after the 6th semester of enrollment, through staff positions, you have the opportunity to receive more achievement scholarship money. Staff positions include: librarians, field staff, drum majors, equipment staff and uniform staff.

Achievement scholarships are now awarded in dollar amounts rather than the previously awarded credit hours. It is highly likely that the band achievement scholarships will remain at the levels outlined on p. 2 instead of rising with the cost of tuition. However, please note that all increases to the band's achievement scholarship allotment will be passed on proportionally. Prior commitments based on percentages of tuition will be honored until the agreement expires. Continuation of awards will be based on the award structure in place at the time.

ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT

I HEREBY AGREE to abide with the following terms and conditions:

Fall Semester (Marching Band - MUS 419E)

1. You must register for and perform as a member of the University of Hawai‘i Marching Band (MUS 419E)
2. You must actively participate and regularly attend the activities, rehearsals, and performances of the University of Hawai‘i “Rainbow Warrior” Marching Band.
3. Your scholarship will be withdrawn if you receive a “D” or lower in the course.
4. You must bring all applicable equipment and supplies to each rehearsal including your instrument, music, pencil, charts, drill markers, and lyre.
5. You are responsible for the preparation (including marching cue indications), practice, and playing of all assigned music.
6. You must perform in your assigned pep band and all assigned U.H. athletic arena sports, including, men’s and women’s basketball and men’s and women’s volleyball, commencements, and other engagements.
 - A. You are responsible for finding your own substitute should a schedule conflict arise. You must find a player of the same instrument and part, i.e. a 1st trumpet player must find another 1st trumpet player.
 - B. If you are unable to find your own substitute, you must inform the band director(s) at least two working days in advance before the scheduled performance.
8. For those who play only in the Marching Band and who do not continue to play in a spring band, the period of financial commitment concludes with Fall Commencement.

Spring Semester (Concert Band - MUS 419 B, C, D)

1. You must audition for placement within one of the three concert bands: Symphonic Wind Ensemble (MUS 419B), Symphonic Band (MUS 419C), or Concert Band (MUS 419D) to receive your fully allotted achievement scholarship.
2. You must register for and perform in your assigned concert band section.
3. You must actively participate and regularly attend the activities, rehearsals, and performances of your assigned concert band.
4. You must perform in your assigned pep band and all assigned U.H. athletic arena sports, including, men’s and women’s basketball and men’s and women’s volleyball, commencements, and other engagements.
 - A. You are responsible for finding your own substitute should a schedule conflict arise. You must find a player of the same instrument and part, i.e. a 1st trumpet player must find another 1st trumpet player.
 - B. If you are unable to find your own substitute, you must inform the band director(s) at least two working days in advance before the scheduled performance.
5. Your scholarship will be withdrawn if you receive a “D” or lower in the course.
6. You must bring all applicable equipment and supplies to each rehearsal including your instrument, mutes, music, and pencil.
7. You are responsible for the preparation (including rehearsal cues), practice, and playing of all assigned music.
8. You must continue to perform for the remaining engagements of your assigned pep band in the Spring Semester.
9. Fall Semester Requirements that apply to Pep Bands are still in effect during the Spring Semester.
10. You must perform at Spring Commencement, if assigned. Failure to do so, without permission from the Director’s will result in your scholarship allotment being lowered by 20%.
